




FROM 25 MAY 2018. THE GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION NO. 2016/679 ("GDPR") WILL BE DIRECTLY APPLICABLE TO ALL ENTITIES, **PRIVATE** OR PUBLIC. ESTABLISHED WITHIN THE **EUROPEAN UNION** ("EU") OR OUTSIDE THE EU IF THEY IMPLEMENT PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA RELATED TO THE OFFERING OF GOODS OR SERVICES ON THE EU TERRITORY OR TO THE MONITORING OF DATA SUBJECTS IN THE EU.


HOW THE "GDPR 3D" OFFER CAN HELP YOU?

A FIVE STEPS PROGRAM



- + External DPO services
- + Organization of the audit and of the personal data action and governance plan

- + Implementation/assistance with the maintenance of the register (mandatory for companies employing more than 250 persons)
- + Legal assistance of in-house DPO: trainings, hot-line/support, monitoring



MAPPING OF YOUR PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

- + Identification of the various **processing** of personal data
- + Identification of the various categories of personal data processed
- + Identification of the **purposes**of the data processing operations
- + Identification of the **operators** (internal or externale, i.e. data processors)
- + Identification of the **flows** (origin and destination of the data)



IDENTIFYING AND PRIORITIZING THE ACTIONS TO BE CONDUCTED

- + Determination of the legal basis of each processing
- + Review of the informative mentions and of the privacy policy
- + Review of the contracts with data processors
- + Determination of how to exercise the rights of the data subjects (withdrawal of the consent, right of access, right to rectification, portability, etc.)



IMPLEMENTING YOUR COMPLIANCE

- + Transverse organization of internal processes
- + Implementation of privacy impact assessments (PIA*)
- + Taking into account the privacy by design and the privacy by default for the conception of new services/ products
- + Management of the claims from the concerned persons
- + Building a training and communication plan for employees



DOCUMENTING YOUR COMPLIANCE

- + Update of the processing register including PIA, documents framing transfers outside the EU (standard contractual clauses, Binding Corporate Rules, etc.), procedures for the persons to exercise their rights, contracts with data processors, internal procedures in case of data breach, etc
- + Monitoring and observing the legislative, regulatory and case law evolutions

WHAT SANCTIONS IN CASE OF NON-COMPLIANCE? Companies will be **self-responsible** and must be able to demonstrate to the supervisory authority, at any time, their compliance with the GDPR.

Failing to demonstrate said compliance, they face financial sanctions up to:


